Australian Alpaca Association Ltd 2022 National Alpaca Show Update #7B – June 2022 <u>Clarifying - Entry passes and parking</u>

In response to a few queries, I'd like to clarify some of the detail about entry passes and parking, and hope to alleviate any concern or confusion ...

Entry Passes:

The RA&HS of SA will provide one adult entry pass for every three halter entries. This means that an entry pass is allocated for your first halter entry, then your fourth entry, then your seventh, then the tenth etc.. So if your halter team comprises five alpacas, you will receive two entry passes to the Royal Adelaide Show.

For those who have fleece entries, but are not bringing alpacas, I am hoping to be able to secure entry passes for you also, but am yet to have the details confirmed.

Parking:

The secure parking details outlined in the NAS Update #7 are optional! Some of you may recall that there was a float stolen (and then safely returned) at a recent National Show. In response to this, I have been asked to find secure parking for those who would prefer this option. There is free street parking within a 10 to 15 minute walk of the Showgrounds, but the parking that is closer to the Showgrounds does incur a fee! For those travelling from afar, you may be able to find accommodation that includes parking options as well.

Renew your AAA Membership:
