STOCKMANSHIP KEY CODE DESCRIPTIONS

Points may be deducted for the following reasons and any safety issues must be stopped immediately and corrected to avoid dangerous situations.

Comments	Judging Code
Lack of attention – Alpaca looking around and not paying attention to handler.	LA
Step out – Alpacas feet step outside of the boundary of the station	SO
Rushing	R
Refusal – R1,R2,R3 Each refusal denotes loss of 3 points 3 refusals per challenge – move on to next challenge, refusal examples – restart station, step back from station, refusal to move forward	REF
Off course – (circle on sheet) Handler/team cannot place above a competitor that correctly completes the course. Missing Station or going out of order	OC
Leaping – Alpaca leaps forward, sideways or backwards	L
Alpaca gets loose at any point during course (Disqualification)	DQ
Rough handling or excessive force or jerking	RH
Loose lead/long lead – Holding lead too slack or too long	LL
Short Lead/hand on clip – advised: hold lead 15cms from clip for best J-lead	SL
Poor sportsmanship – Handler shows bad behavior towards alpaca or any personnel involved at event	PS
Balking/hesitation – alpaca doesn't move forward freely	B
Misguidance – lack of attention of handler. Handler not aware of where alpaca going. Leading in front of alpaca	M
Dragging – Pulling alpaca with force instead of encouragement	D
Poor line up – not allowing alpaca reasonable space to approach and assess stations	PL
Release of gate – handler must have contact with gate at all times ie. Hand or foot	G
Lack of team effort/handler rapport	TE
Lack of flow – Not working accurately and smoothly with a reasonable amount of speed	LF
Loud voice commands	V
Leading from the wrong side- It is ok to change sides if needed to perform station	WS
