

Young Judges Qualification and scoring 2020 National Alpaca Show

Representation at the 2020 National Event will consist of participants from Vic (2) NSW (2) Qld (2) Tas (1) WA (1) SA (2), totaling a possible 10 competitors from across Australia.

Young competitors are to compete at young judging competitions throughout their home states at workshop and official stand-alone events, Regional Shows and their home state capital Royal Show.

Events and shows will be graded and scored as follows:

Workshop or Regional Show

Placing points

Alpaca Halter class:	1st = 10.	2nd = 8.	3rd = 6
Alpaca Fleece class:	1st = 5.	2nd = 3.	3rd = 1

Home State Capital Royal Show

Placing points

Halter & Fleece classes 1st = 30 2nd = 20 3rd = 15 point

In the event that a home state royal cannot be attended, an appeal to the AYE committee can be lodged for justification ratification, which would allow them to compete in another state.

State Capital Royal Show:

Placing points - prior approval required

Halter & Fleece classes 1st = 20

2nd = 15

3rd = 10 point

The highest scorers from each state has earnt and gained the opportunity to represent their state at the 2020 Australian National Alpaca Show.

Dress code for the young judging needs to be professional with pants, shirts and suit jackets. Jeans regardless of colour are inappropriate.
