IMPORTANT SHOW INFO

At the recent Canberra Royal Show, the AAA received a visit from Work Health and Safety officials. Due to some serious safety concerns regarding the use of fans on pens, an audit of electrical appliance use is being undertaken by an electrical engineer to ensure that everything is in line with the Australian Standards. The Board has put a suspension on fans as of the 2nd April 2019 “NO FANS ARE ALLOWED AT ANY ALPACA SHOW” until the Board receives an Electrical Engineers Report on our electrical setups at Shows. We are working on resolving this issue as quickly as possible as everyone understands that it is important to all exhibitors. The safety of people and animals is of upmost importance.

From 1 July 2019 an admin/training Levy will be introduced on all halter and fleece show entries of \$2.00 halter and \$1.00 fleece. For Convenors that already have done your Show Schedule, please adjust the amounts where necessary.
