Update #7 – June 2022

Entry passes and parking

Well, it's real now – the entries for the 2022 AAA National Alpaca Show are open and the first entries have been received ... !!

To assist with your planning, here are a few details:

Entry Passes:

The Royal Adelaide Show will provide entry passes to exhibitors at the rate of one (adult) pass for every three halter entries. Those with official duties will receive a day pass for each day of their responsibilities.

For those with the Promotional Sites, the Royal Adelaide Show will provide one nine-day pass and nine one-day passes for each of the five sites.

If additional entry passes are needed, there are a couple of options:

- Annual membership of RA&HS of SA provides one transferable and one non-transferable pass for the nine days of the Show. The cost of annual membership is \$180.
- Daily entry passes. Adult price \$28. Child price \$17.50. Show tickets can be purchased at the gate, or pre-purchased from Ticketek or Foodland.

Parking Options:

The Adelaide Showground is located less than a kilometre from the CBD of Adelaide and parking around the Showground is limited. On-street parking around the Showground is generally not a practical option for exhibitors and their staff and the City of Unley strictly enforce the parking restrictions which apply in the streets around the Show ... !!

There are a few parking options:

- Morphettville Racecourse for \$20 per day per vehicle for trucks and floats. This needs to be pre-booked to secure a spot.
- Vehicle parking is available in the Parklands adjacent to the Adelaide Showground at a daily rate of \$15 per day. This is paid at entry each day.

- Additional parking is available at the Netball SA Stadium, Railway terrace, Mile End (opposite Bunnings). This site is fully sealed, well-lit and will be staffed from 7am until 10pm (Friday 11pm).
- Parking will be provided at SA Power Networks staff car park Railway Terrace, Mile End on weekends during the Show, when the Netball SA Stadium is being used.

Coaches operate throughout the day to provide free transport between the Mile End parking and the Show.
